JACANZS' aim and scope is to publish articles in various disciplines on at least more than one country of focus of the journal, i.e. Australia and Canada or Canada and Aotearoa New Zealand etc. However, articles which focus on just one country will also be considered ☺

Manuscripts of a maximum of 10,000 words in length (including footnotes and a short bibliography) should be submitted as a Word document, along with a separate short abstract of no more than 250 words, up to a maximum of five key words, author contact details, and institutional affiliation, if any, to Dr. Jatinder Mann (journal editor) at acanzsjournal@gmail.com

Deadline: 30 November 2020

Manuscripts should be formatted according to the Chicago reference style. All manuscripts should be anonymised and will undergo double blind peer review, after an initial vetting by the journal editor.

JACANZS will also have a book reviews section, which will be edited by Emily Cornish (University of Michigan). Books that look at more than one country of focus of the journal will be prioritised, but books that look at just one country are also welcome ☺.
